# Of a Tax-Exempt Corporation

Pursuant to A.R.S. 10-3202

# The 57<sup>th</sup> AHC Memorial Fund

- 1. Name: The Name of the Corporation is: The 57th AHC Memorial Fund
- Purpose: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: To build a memorial in honor of the members of the 57<sup>th</sup> Assault Helicopter Company (AHC) which served in Vietnam from 1967 to 1973.
- 3. <u>Character of Affairs</u>: To build a memorial in honor of the members of the 57<sup>th</sup> AHC which served in Vietnam from 1967 to 1973.
- 4. Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 5. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements,) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
